SEC Thailand's Public Hearing on a revision to rules and regulations of Digital Asset Businesses and ICO portals

Considering a new technological context, many aspects of existing rules and regulations may need to be reviewed. Therefore, the SEC would like to propose a revision to rules and regulations of Digital Asset Businesses (i.e., Exchanges, Brokers, Dealers, Advisory Services, and Digital Asset Fund Managers) and ICO portals and seek public comments to ensure appropriate regulatory responses.

The revision includes:

- (1) Procedures for applying for a license in undertaking digital asset businesses;
- (2) Rules, conditions, and procedures for undertaking digital asset businesses;
- (3) Procedures for approval of ICO portals; and
- (4) Rules on the establishment of Information Technology Systems for ICO portals
