

SEC Thailand's public hearing on the proposed rules to obligate the digital asset business operators to provide risk information to users and set minimum purchase value per transaction

The Securities and Exchange Commission, Thailand ("SEC") is seeking public comments on the proposal to obligate the digital asset business operators to provide risk information related to investment in cryptocurrency and basic asset allocation before admission to platform to users and set minimum purchase value per transaction at 5,000 Baht

Under this proposal, the digital asset business operators will be obligated to:

- (1) Disclose risk information as proposed by SEC to user before admission to platform.
- (2) Set up a minimum purchase transaction value at 5,000 Baht, except for purchase of digital tokens that approval for public offering is granted by SEC.
