SEC provides information regarding the Reports on Acquisition or Disposition of Securities (Form 246-2) in the case of Miss Supaporn Pimphong

Mr. Anek Yooyuen, Deputy Secretary-General and Spokesperson of the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), stated that in light of the public interest in the case concerning Miss Supaporn Pimphong, the person who submitted the Form 246-2 reports, as well as media inquiries regarding the status and progress of the SEC's actions in this case, the SEC would like to provide information on two key issues as follows:

First, regarding the Form 246-2 information disseminated to the public, the SEC has taken action as previously communicated last week. In brief, the SEC has removed such information from the Form 246-2 reporting system after posting cautionary notes periodically.

Second, regarding the SEC's enforcement action against the person who reported false information in the system, the SEC publicly disclosed on 10 July 2026 that the SEC and the Economic Crime Suppression Division (ECD) had jointly verified the identity of, and interviewed, the reporting person, with the aim of ensuring accurate understanding and reducing investor confusion. The matter is currently in the process of affording the reporting person the right to be heard, in accordance with due process of law. The SEC will disclose further details once the action is concluded.

The SEC has taken the incident seriously. In handling the matter to date, the SEC has monitored developments, listened to information and views from various perspectives, and clarified its actions to prevent confusion arising from the dissemination of inaccurate information. The SEC also remains open to comments and suggestions on additional measures, which will be further assessed for their effectiveness in consultation with relevant stakeholders, with a view to preventing and deterring incidents of a similar nature and continuing to ensure confidence in accurate information in the capital market.
