Investment governance codes or stewardship codes have been internationally recognised as important tools for strengthening Institutional Investors' competitiveness in domestic and global markets, and supporting the role of active and responsible shareholders in promoting sustainable and competitive business operation by listed companies, to achieve long-term sustainable returns to clients, financial market stability and economic growth.

The SEC Thailand launched the I Code in February 2017. The I Code Principles require Institutional Investors to integrate good governance in investment management. Active stewardship results in benefits not only to Thai Institutional Investors and their clients, but also promotes integration of







environmental, social and corporate governance criteria in measuring listed company performance, and sustainable development and growth of the Thai and regional capital markets.
